- Minimum 9 hours from two schools outside the major (based on course prefix); note that courses which are cross-listed under two schools count as BOTH schools; eg, APPH/BIOL courses count as both APPH and BIOL
- Minimum 9 hours 3000 or higher
- Maximum 6 hours Special Topics, or 3 hours Research and 3 hours Special Topics, pre-approved by the HMED committee
- Maximum 3 hours Transfer credits
- Taken on a letter-grade basis with final grade of C or higher
- Is NOT fulfilling a Core A-E degree requirement
- Is in the designated block of courses allowed to double-count in the major, as determined by the major advisor
