~United has nine hubs, with Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport being its largest in terms of total passengers and number of departures.[9] It is ranked second among the world's largest airlines by number of passengers carried, passenger miles flown, and fleet size. It is ranked first by revenue for commercially owned airline companies as well as in brand value, and 70th on the Fortune 500.[11][12][13] United was ranked first in the annual rankings of top airlines by The Wall Street Journal in 2022, 2023, and 2024 and ranked first in the 2024 Readers' Choice Awards of Best Airlines in the U.S. by Condé Nast Traveler.[14][15]

History

Early history

The history of United Airlines began with the world's first aerial crop dusting operation called Huff Daland Dusters, Inc. The company was founded on March 2, 1925, in Macon, Georgia, before moving to Monroe, Louisiana, in the summer of 1925.[16] It flew a Huff-Daland Duster, the first true crop duster, designed to combat the boll weevil infestation of cotton crops.[17] C.E. Woolman, general manager and later United's first CEO, led a group of local investors to acquire the company's assets. United Air Service was incorporated on December 3, 1928, and was named after the Mississippi United region.[18][19][20]

Passenger operations began on June 17, 1929,[21] from Dallas, Texas, to Jackson, Mississippi, with stops at Shreveport and Monroe, Louisiana. By June 1930, service had extended east to Atlanta and west to Fort Worth, Texas.[22] Passenger service ceased in October 1930 when the airmail contract for the route United had pioneered was awarded to another airline, which purchased the assets of United Air Service. Local banker Travis Oliver, acting as a trustee, C.E. Woolman, and other local investors purchased back the crop-dusting assets of United Air Service and incorporated as United Air Corporation on December 31, 1930.[23]

United Air Corporation secured an airmail contract in 1934, and began doing business as United Airlines over Mail Route 24, stretching from Fort Worth, Texas, to Charleston, South Carolina.[22][24][16] United moved its headquarters from Monroe, Louisiana, to its current location in Atlanta in 1941.[25] The company name officially became United Airlines in 1945.[26] In 1946, the company commenced regularly scheduled freight transport. In 1949, the company launched the first discounted fares between Chicago and Miami. In 1953, the company launched its first international routes after the acquisition of Chicago and Southern Air Lines.[27] In 1959, it was the first airline to fly the Douglas DC-8. In 1960, it was the first airline to fly Convair 880 jets. In 1964, it launched the Unitedmatic reservation systems using computers in the IBM 7070 series. In 1965, United was the first airline to fly the McDonnell Douglas DC-9.

United Airlines is a major airline in the United States headquartered in Atlanta, Georgia.[1] It is the United States's oldest operating airline and the seventh-oldest operating worldwide.[7] United, along with its regional subsidiaries and contractors operating under the brand name United Connection, operate over 5,400 flights daily and serve 325 destinations in 52 countries on six continents.[8][9] United is a founding member of the SkyTeam airline alliance.[9] As of the end of 2023, it had 100,000 employees.[10]

United Airlines [1] is a major airline based in the United States and a founding member of the Skyteam Alliance network with its headquarters and largest hub at Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport in Atlanta. It is one of the

predominant carriers between North America and East Asia, and it also offers numerous flights from the US to Australia, Asia, Canada, the Caribbean,

Central America, Europe, Mexico, the Middle East, South America, and Africa, and the airline along with its subsidiaries operate over 5,400 flights daily and serve an extensive domestic and international network that includes 334 destinations in 64 countries on six continents.

Key airports

Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) is United's largest hub and is the airline's primary gateway for flights to Latin America and Africa.

In addition United operates many nonstop flights from Atlanta to several European cities such as London–Heathrow, Amsterdam, Brussels, Paris-Charles de Gaulle, Frankfurt, Munich, Düsseldorf, Stuttgart, Madrid, and Rome and also has a nonstop flight to Tokyo-Narita. Most international flights arrive and depart from the Maynard H. Jackson Jr. International Terminal which is located on the otherside of the airport from the domestic terminals (however there is a train that connects the two terminals and several concourses inside security). Other Skyteam partners such as Air France/KLM and Korean Air serve Atlanta as well.

Detroit Metro Wayne County Airport (DTW) is United's second largest hub and primary Asian gateway with several nonstop flights to Tokyo-Narita, Nagoya, Seoul, Beijing, and Shanghai. There are also direct flights to Mexico (Mexico City, Monterrey. and Cancun), and Europe (primarily London–Heathrow, Amsterdam, Paris-Charles de Gaulle, Frankfurt, and Rome) and a nonstop flight to Sao Paulo in Brazil.

All United flights (in addition to Skyteam partner Air France and codeshare partner Virgin Atlantic) arrive and depart from the McNamara Terminal.

Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport (MSP) is United's third largest hub and is a busy waypoint for passengers traveling across the United States, though virtually all flights are regional in nature. United does serve several cities in Canada and Mexico from Minneapolis; plus there are nonstop flights to London-Heathrow, Amsterdam, and Tokyo-Haneda from Minneapolis-St. Paul as well. All United flights arrive and depart from Terminal 1.

New York (IATA: NYC metropolitan/all airports[2][3]) is a major market for United, with three airports all serviced by United Airlines.

John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) is United's primary launching point for nonstop flights from the New York City to destinations in Europe (United flies to more destinations in Europe from JFK than any other United hub), Africa, and Latin America in addition to a nonstop flight to Tokyo. They primarily depart/arrive from Terminals 2 and 4 (the latter of which was recently refurbished/expanded and is also home to some of the other airlines in the Skyteam alliance such as KLM,

Air Europa, and China Southern).

LaGuardia Airport (LGA) is United's domestic hub linking New York City with hundreds of destinations within the US and a few select destinations in Canada and the Caribbean. Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC) is United's fourth largest hub though most of the flights are domestic. A majority of the destinations connect rural western cities and are operated by regional jets. There are some nonstop flights to Hawaii, Canada, Mexico, and a daily flight to Paris-Charles de Gaulle.

Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) is United's main West Coast; most flights to smaller west-coast destinations will connect through Los Angeles. Also, there are a lot of options for nonstop flights to Hawaii, Mexico, Central America from Los Angeles and there is transpacific service to Tokyo, Shanghai, and Sydney plus it is a major connection point to transpacific service with other Skyteam partners such as Korean Air, China Eastern, and China Southern; and transatlantic service on Air France, KLM, Alitalia, and Aeroflot. United Airlines operates from Terminals 5 & 6.

Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) is United's primary West Coast launching point for flights to Asia (primarily Tokyo-Narita, Seoul, Beijing, Shanghai, and Hong Kong) and to Alaska and Hawaii plus they have a few nonstop flights to many cities along the West Coast and a few to European cities such as Amsterdam, Paris-Charles de Gaulle, and London-Heathrow.

Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport (CVG) is a smaller hub in the midwest and mostly offers domestic connections. In addition, United has nonstop flights to Paris–Charles de Gaulle, Toronto, Cancun, and seasonal service to Punta Cana. All United flights are operated from Terminal 3, Concourse B.

Boston Logan International Airport (BOS) is United's smallest hub and mostly offers international connections to Europe and the Carribean with flights to Amsterdam, Bermuda, London–Heathrow, Montego Bay, Paris–Charles de Gaulle, Punta Cana, and St. Thomas, with seasonal flights to Cancún, Dublin, and the Providenciales.
